

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(Shortwood Road, Pucklechurch) (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Foot Passengers, Pedal Cycles and Equestrians) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended have made an order the effect of which has:-

- a) closed, temporarily, to vehicles, Foot Passengers, Pedal Cycles and Equestrians the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.
- b) suspended, temporarily, when signs are covered, the South Gloucestershire Council (Abson Road, Abson) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles of Over 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight) Order 2006 in so far as it relates to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice to facilitate the alternative routes for heavy vehicles.

This order was required for the following reason: in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon new footway and cycleway construction works. The order will be operative from 2 September 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **4 days** duration.

Schedule 1

Shortwood Road - that length that extends from its junction with Siston Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 550 metres

Schedule 2

Abson Road - for its entire length

Alternative route: B4465, Abson Road, Naishcombe Hill, A420, A4174, B4465 and vice versa
