

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(Various Footpaths in the Parishes of Siston and Pucklechurch) (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Foot Passengers) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended have made an order the effect of which has closed, temporarily, to foot passengers the lengths of footpath specified in the Schedule to this notice.

This order was required for the following reason: in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon site clearance works. The order became operative from 3 January 2023 for a maximum period of six months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **5 days** duration.

Schedule:

1. LPU/57/10 - the entire length
2. PSN/44/10 - the entire length
3. PSN/46/10 - the entire length
4. PSN/45/10 - from its junction with footpath PSN/46/10 in an easterly direction for a distance of 100 metres

Alternative route: Siston Lane, Gibbs Lane, PSN/33/10, PSN/48/10, PSN/47/10, LPU/58 and vice versa
