The route generally starts in Emersons Green before heading for Shortwood and Pucklechurch. It then goes via Siston Lane and Deanery Road to The Griffin at Bridgeyate. From here it goes to North Common, along Mill Lane, then Tower Road South to North Street and High Street, Oldland Common. Next is Cherry Garden Lane, Bitton and Kenilworth Drive, Willsbridge. It then turns left towards Bitton as far as The White Hart before heading back to Keynsham, calling at the station and into town. There are also connections to Yate and Westerleigh at certain times.

Pay on the bus by cash or card. Concessionary passes accepted*
