


Pucklechurch Parish and Emersons Green Town Amendments to the parish boundary consultation

12 December 2022 to 3 January 2023

We are reviewing the way decisions are made on local issues in your area and we want to hear your views. We have sought the views of both Pucklechurch Parish Council and Emerson's Green Town Council and propose to amend the current boundary for Pucklechurch parish so that the properties at Lyde Green are moved from being in Pucklechurch parish to form part of Emerson's Green Town Council. We consider that this change would make the parish arrangements more efficient.

The proposed changes to the boundary are shown on the map below:



The consultation options

There are two possible options, these are:

Option 1: the parish boundary is amended to move the properties in the area marked red on the attached plan change from being in Pucklechurch Parish to being part of Emersons Green Town Council.

The change in the parish boundary would mean that the properties at Lyde Green would cease to be represented by parish councillors from Pucklechurch and would instead be represented by town councillors from Emersons Green.

Option 2: there is no change to the boundary and no change in representation for the Lyde Green properties.

Why are we carrying out the review?

As part of the planning for this review we wrote to all parish and town councils asking if they would like to make any changes to their arrangements. Pucklechurch Parish Council has asked if we could make changes to the current parish boundary.

What happens next?

All the responses to the consultation will be reviewed and used in a report to go to our Regulatory Committee on 12 January 2023.

If a decision is made to change the parish area, the change would take effect from the local elections in May 2023.
