## **TUESDAY 25TH JULY - BURNHAM ON SEA**

Head to the seaside for Fish and Chips or try your luck at the amusements. Browse the High Street or treat yourself to an ice cream and enjoy the sea air watching the world go by.

## **TUESDAY 15TH AUGUST - MORETON-IN-MARSH**

Visit the historic traveller's town on Market Day and browse the stalls amongst the picturesque High Street. Look out for Curfew Tower and White Hart Royal where Charles I sheltered during the Civil War. Wellington Aviation Museum is located just off of the High St (entry- £3) or visit The Bell Inn, said to be JRR Tolkien's inspiration for the 'Prancing Pony', Middle Earth's most famous pub in 'The Lord of the Rings'.

## **FRIDAY 1ST SEPTEMBER - CHIPPENHAM**

A huge amount to see, look out for The Yelde Hall, built in the 15th Century or if you want to know more about this historic town, visit Chippenham Museum. Friday is market day so browse the stalls and look for the Buttercross where milk and cheese used to be sold. Emery Gate Shopping Centre has lots of shops to browse if this is more your cup of tea!

## **TUESDAY 24<sup>th</sup> | OCTOBER - BRADFORD ON AVON**

The River Avon weaves through this beautiful town as well as the Kennet and Avon canal. Enjoy coffee and cake at The Shambles, the only timber framed building, it used to be the medieval meat market but now has a variety of cafes and shops. See the Town Bridge and the Lock Up, the Iron Duke or head to the Saxon Church of St Laurence dating back to the 11th Century.

## **FRIDAY 24TH NOVEMBER**

A scenic drive through the countryside to Street and Clarks Village. Christmas Shopping at this outlet with up to 60% off RRP, lots of places to eat to choose from in-between shopping!
