Tunnelling 80 metres below the Ring Road




South Gloucestershire Council has been tunnelling the length of 80 metres under a section of the A4174 Avon Ring Road to replace a badly damaged drainage pipe, three metres below the road surface.

It has been a complex and labour-intensive project with the crew tunnelling along the pipe at around one and a half metres a day. Around 300 tonnes of waste material has been painstakingly excavated by hand, around the same weight as a Boeing 747 aeroplane.

The £500,000 flood resilience scheme, which is now complete, was the longest tunnelling operation of its kind in South Gloucestershire.

Work is progressing well on the new slip road to ease congestion at the Mangotsfield Sort It recycling Centre. From Spring 2023, the entrance for residents will be via a dedicated lane on Carsons Link Road from the A4174 Ring Road roundabout. We will continue to keep you updated on this work.

Is your vehicle winter ready?

It is important that your vehicle is well-maintained and serviced for winter conditions. We want to help you to make your winter driving as safe as possible, even in extreme weather conditions.

Here are some tips:

- Battery: The winter can be a lot harder on your car so ensure that your battery is in good condition, charged and topped up.
- Tyres: Check your tyres have plenty of tread depth and are inflated to the correct pressure.
- Antifreeze: You need to also make sure there's antifreeze in your cooling system. You will need a 50-50 mix of antifreeze and water for the winter to protect your engine against freezing temperatures.
- Be prepared: You can also carry a few essentials in your car for winter driving. This could include an ice-scraper, de-icer, first-aid kit and blankets or warm clothes in case of a breakdown.
