Lyde Green Common/Common Connections Project

Spring onwards

South Glos council are awaiting confirmation of their bid to the government to have a share of funding to help connect and enhance the wildlife corridors in our area. Part of this long term, 4 year project will involve Lyde Green common as this is noted as a key corridor in the area. Lyde green OpenSpace will look to actively be involved in this by way of resident engagement and project creations for the common that might not fall into the connections project itself i.e furniture installation, access, and events (Mud Pies/Litterpicks/brush piling/hedgerow management)

We are currently in the process of finalising interpretation signs for Lyde Green Common.

Willowherb Road Planters

Spring 2022

Lyde Green OpenSpace have been in talks with South Glos council regarding additional planters along Willowherb Rd, opposite School Square. We have also been in contact with the road safety team at south Glos and had an idea to attach road safety design plaques to the planters designed by the school children at Lyde Green Primary. This was agreed as a great idea and a road safety day at the school s planned for late February 2022. We feel that this is an important project to be involved in as this will prevent badly parked cars from the area and reduce the risk of accidents whilst reducing pollution and having lovely pollinating plants for all to enjoy.
