

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(Coxgrove Hill, Pucklechurch) (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Foot
Passengers, Pedal Cycles and Equestrians) Order 2025

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, foot passengers, pedal cycles and equestrians that length of Coxgrove Hill which extends from its junction with Grove Paddock in a south easterly direction for a distance of 200 metres.

This order is required for the following reason: in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon overhead cabling works on or adjacent to the highway. The order will be operative from 16 June 2025 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **5 days** duration.

Alternative route: Parkfield Road, Westerleigh Road, Henfield Road and vice versa.
