### Working with Communities in Rural West of England

West of England Rural Network are starting a project aimed at strengthening community led action across the West of England.

We want to ensure that the specific challenges people face in our rural areas are heard and addressed. We want to understand what services and support are already available, and where the gaps are, so we can help communities create their own solutions to local problems.

Here's what we'll be doing:

- Listening to Rural Voices: We'll be gathering information from what people tell us directly through surveys and conversations with local groups like parish councils and village halls. We'll be working with other local organisations to make sure we hear from as many as possible. This will help us understand what's working well and what needs to be improved. We'll then share what we learn with everyone so we can work together on solutions. We really do want to hear from Town and Parish Councils, your views are critical.
- **Building a Stronger Network:** We want to make it easier for local groups to connect and support each other. At WERN we have really good connections with many rural communities, through our Village Agents or our work supporting key facilities such as Village Halls and Community Transport groups. We'll be improving how we communicate, making sure everyone has access to the information and opportunities they need. We also be want to encourage more groups, and especially Town and Parish Councils, to become WERN members, It's free of charge! beneficial. We're working to become a better voice for these communities and help them work together.
